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
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From the Mighty Pen of Sanjay



hinkers, through the ages, have attributed the cause of the world unrest or peacelessness of mind to various factors. Some have opined that 'economic disparity' is the root cause of all the struggles and clashes between man and man or between groups of people in the same country. 'Class differences' or various 'economic ideologies', they say, have divided mankind into opposing camps, bent upon dislodging each other from the position they hold. To a great extent, this is true.

'Political differences' have been considered to be another major cause of personal bickering, sectional feuds, party rivalries or confrontation between one nation and another. Politics has generated a lot of heat in human relations and has led the various nations to bloodshed and bitterness.

'Religion', which should have been a cementing force between man and man and also between man and his Creator, has unluckily been serving the Devil, which it should have indeed eliminated. Men have, during the last twenty-five hundred years, pounced on each other and one another in the name of religion. Religion, which was supposed to be a bridge for leading man to the land of peace, has proved to be a gulf between one group of persons and another. It promised to give to man the muchwanted peace on a platter. Instead, it has become a weapon to wage wars, which were named by the fanatics as Holy Wars, Jihads or *Dharma Yuddh*.

'Linguistic differences' have been another cause for regional fights. Language, which was meant to be a vehicle of thought, an instrument of

expression or a medium for exchange of views and was thus supposed to bring about understanding and amity between people, inhabiting two tracts of land, has, instead of lifting man above the level of animal, awakened the brute in him. Instead of bringing about the meeting of minds, it has built up unscalable high walls between the children of God or the children of the same motherland.

Similarly, the 'colour difference', 'the racial differences' and 'caste differences' have also been very big factors leading to exploitation and hatred among the people.

All these and many other factors are, no doubt, responsible for peacelessness. They have, no doubt, sown the seeds of discord. But, deep probing will reveal that these causes are rooted in man's own mental unrest. The mind that lacks peace, radiates unrest. That is why they say that wars are born in the minds of men. Hence, the basic requirement is that man's mind should be peaceful because he is the basic unit of the society. Just as one rotten fish contaminates the whole pond, so does an uneasy individual in a family, in a locality or in a section of the society becomes instrumental in inciting people or making them restless. But, why should man's mind become uneasy? What is the cause or reason of this?

Vices are the Cause of Unrest

Deep reflection will lead you to the conclusion that any one of the five vices - lust, anger, greed, attachment and pride — is sufficient by itself to cause discord. It is an indisputable truth that he, who becomes angry, not only loses his own peace of mind but also deprives others also of their peace, either by his bitter words, or by means of violent fights or by retaliation. He, who suffers from greed, resorts to dishonesty by means of adulteration, window-dressing or mere show, bribery, evasion of income tax or other similar means. His mind is never restful, because

Editorial

2020: MOST AUSPICIOUS YEAR FOR HUMANITY



n early December, the last month of 2019 and the Decade, Prajapita Brahma Kumaris Ishwariya Vishwa Vidyalaya (PBKIVV) was greatly honoured to receive the Hon'ble President of India, H.E. Ram Nath Kovindji, the First Lady, Shrimati Savita Kovind, and their daughter with other members of their large entourage. It was a humbling privilege to welcome the most dignified First Citizen of India as he inaugurated the National Conference on 'Empowerment of Women for Social Transformation' at Diamond Hall of the Brahma Kumaris' Shantivan Campus, on 6th December 2019.

During his Inaugural Speech, the President narrated a heart-touching experience about Revered Rajyogini Dadi Jankiji, Head of the Brahma Kumaris: About a year back, Divine Sister BK Asha and Brother BK Brij Mohan had visited the Rashtrapati Bhawan to convey greetings from Dadiji and the entire BK divine family, as well as put forth a request from Dadiji to visit the President in Delhi. In his own very royal and humble way, the President asked them to convey to Dadiji that rather than her take any trouble to travel, he himself would visit the Brahma Kumaris Headquarters to receive Dadiji's blessings. So amidst great preparation and excitement, the auspicious day of 6th December dawned when the Hon'ble President came to Shantivan, and spent about 4 hours with us!

In the Welcome Speech, I myself very respectfully shared the deep sentiments of happiness of the BK family on hosting the Hon'ble President, who had enhanced the splendor of the gathering. I further expressed concern over the dire situation surrounding safety and well-being of young children and women, some of whom have become helpless victims of beastly-natured individuals. The Conference on Empowerment of Women was most timely and essential to help awaken the psyche of society to their responsibilities towards the females of this land.

Rajyogini Dadi Jankiji showered blessings of spiritual wisdom on all in a very gracious and enthusiastic manner, praising the values and concerns of the President and all Political Heads of State in building a stronger and secure nation. Revered Dadiji also shared her personal experiences of sustenance by our Founding Father, Pitashri Brahma Baba, who had visualized in the late 1930s the need for Spiritual Empowerment of all humans, and secondly, the active participation of women in spreading God's message of purity, peace and love.

The moment we had been waiting for finally arrived when we were gifted with an impactful Inaugural Speech by our President, the highlights of which are as below:

The President said that the theme of this National Conference is very relevant. The Brahma Kumaris is carrying out empowerment of women for social change

in the true sense. He emphasized that a society based on equality and harmony could only be possible by empowering women.

The President said that women's safety is a very serious issue. A lot of work has been done on this subject but much remains to be done. The incidents of demonic attacks on girls shake the conscience of the country. It is the responsibility of every parent to instill among their boys a strong feeling of respect for women.

He further said it was his belief that in cases under POCSO Act, convicts should be deprived of the right of mercy petition. He felt they do not need any such right.

The President said education is important for empowerment of women. It is true that when you educate a boy, it benefits one family, but when you educate a girl, it benefits two families. It is a fact that children of an educated woman do not remain uneducated.

Remembering B. R. Ambedkar on his death anniversary, the President said that Ambedkar always gave priority to women empowerment. He also paid respect to Pitashri Brahma Baba, saying that by profession a Jewel Merchant, Brahma Baba's visionary insights and motivation made every Brahma Kumari sister into a jewel herself to serve society and the world.

During other Sessions of the Conference, different aspects of Women Empowerment were discussed. The Teachings and Experiences of the Brahma Kumaris Institution were appreciated in bringing about long-lasting and visible change in society.

Further, we are sharing some very precious jewels of elevated Godly versions (extract) from a recent Avyakt Murli, where the methods for achieving Self-Empowerment are beautifully described:

"It is only because the spiritual children are extremely loving that they are constant companions and co-operative with God the Father. Where there is love, you become constantly co-operative companions of the One you love. The Father cannot carry out any task without the children and the children cannot carry out any task without the Father. This is why, from the beginning of establishment, along with creating Brahma, the Father also created Brahmins."

"A companion is someone who fulfils the responsibility of companionship at every step, with every thought and every word. Those who fulfil the responsibility of companionship at every step, that is, those who *follow* the *Father* are true companions; they are eternal companions. True companions do not need to make effort over whether they should take a step in this way or that way. By placing your steps in the footsteps of the Father, you automatically cannot place your steps anywhere else."

"In your intellects you are aware that: Whatever is the inheritance of the Father's unlimited treasures is mine. In your hearts, there is just the Comforter of Hearts. There cannot be anything else – just the heart and the Comforter of Hearts. So, since the Father is merged in your remembrance, then, as is

your awareness, so is your stage, and your actions are automatically according to that."

"All of you have the enthusiasm to move constantly forward in service. There wouldn't be anyone who doesn't have enthusiasm to move forward in service. If you didn't have zeal and enthusiasm, how would you have come here? You have zeal and enthusiasm and it will remain all the time. Whilst moving forward together, with zeal and enthusiasm, are you all constantly free from obstacles? Zeal and enthusiasm are very good, but there is a difference between doing service free from obstacles and doing service in which you are constantly overcoming obstacles. To be free from obstacles means that you neither become an obstacle for others nor become afraid of any type of obstacle. One is when obstacles come to teach you a lesson. The other is when obstacles come to shake you. If you have learnt your lesson and become firm, that obstacle will then be transformed into love."

"To be a Brahmin means to *challenge* Maya: Just let the obstacles come! I am victorious. You cannot do anything. Previously you were *friends* of Maya. Now you issue a *challenge* and say that you will become conquerors of Maya. To become a conqueror of Maya means to be victorious. To become a Brahmin means to *challenge* Maya. However, those who *challenge* her experience it to be a game, so that she comes and goes. You are able to recognize her from a distance and chase her away from a distance. You do not *waste* your *time*.

"You were told that you must neither be influenced by obstacles nor become an obstacle for others. *Marks* are accumulated on the basis of this too. One is *purity* and the other is unadulterated remembrance. Let there not be the slightest obstacle in your remembrance. In this way, always keep yourself free from obstacles in service, be content with your virtues and make others content."

"BapDada is also going to tell you about three things which sometimes become an obstacle in service:

- Let there be no type of **attachment** to anything limited. To have attachment to the Father is something else, but let there not be any limited attachment.
- Let there not be any type of **tension** with yourself or with others. Instead of battling with Maya, let there not be any type of conflict with one another.
- Let there not be any type of weak nature.

In fact, the word nature (swabhav) is very good. "Swabhav" means feelings of the self. The self is said to be elevated. There are elevated feelings, there are feelings of the self, there is soul consciousness. However, you use the words "bhav-swabhav" (conflict of feelings and nature) a lot. So that is a weak nature which, from time to time, becomes an obstacle to your flying stage. When your *nature* is elevated, it is like the Father's. If it becomes an obstacle, then it is a weak nature."

"There are many types of tension and the reason for tension is the consciousness of "I". "I did this. I can do this. I alone will do

this." This consciousness of "I" creates tension. This "I" is body consciousness. One thing is, "I am an elevated soul". Another is, "I am So-and-so. I am sensible. I am yogi, I am gyani. I am ahead in service." This consciousness of "I" creates tension. This is why, in some cases, where there needs to be a fast speed in service, it becomes a slow speed. The basis of *speeding* up is to help others move forward. To help them move forward constantly is to move forward yourself."

"The facilities for service are the fortune of your renunciation. However, if you keep this fortune limited by having the consciousness of "I", it won't increase. Make others co-operative and constantly share the fruit of the fortune of renunciation with others and move forward."

"What was Father Brahma's speciality? He always kept the children ahead. "The children are cleverer than me. The children will do this." He had so much renunciation that he even renounced the fortune he received through his renunciation. If anyone praised Brahma because of the love they received or the attainment they had, he would remind them of Shiv Baba, the Father. You will not receive the inheritance from Brahma. You mustn't keep a picture of Brahma. Do not consider Brahma to be everything. This is called renouncing the fortune received through renunciation and becoming engaged in service. By doing this you become doubly great donors."

"Let none of you make your nature be dependent on anything. The Father's nature is the children's nature. What is the Father's nature? His nature is constantly to have benevolent and merciful feelings for every soul. His nature is of uplifting everyone. It is a sweet nature, a nature of humility.

"Constantly keep your balance in life. Let there be a balance in everything. The balance of remembrance and service. Selfrespect finishes arrogance. Remain stable in your self-respect. Let all these things remain in your awareness. Not too entertaining, not too serious; let there be a balance. Be entertaining when you have to be entertaining and be serious when there is a need to be serious."

"Always claim special *blessings* from the Father at Amrit Vela. Every day at Amrit Vela, BapDada opens His apron of *blessings* for you children. You can take as many as you want from that. So, *balance*, *blessings* and thirdly, a *blissful life*."

"Why has BapDada especially kept the time of Amrit Vela for you Brahmin children? Because, at that time, BapDada especially brings the speciality, the service and virtues of every child in front of Him, and He makes the speciality, virtues and service of every child imperishable by giving them a special blessing. BapDada gives each one the sustenance of the blessing of love and co-operation. Shiv Baba is the Bestower of Happiness and the Bestower of Peace, and He gives you sustenance. Just as parents get their children

ready in the morning, they freshen them up and say: Now, go and eat, drink and study all day long, so BapDada also gives this sustenance at Amrit Vela, that is, He fills you with power for the whole day. Any of you can take as many blessings as you want with an honest heart, not with selfish motives. He gives you just that much power to fulfil your intentions. Continue to move along, continue to fly."

Blessing: May you experience supersensuous joy by remaining free from any bondage of the mind and become a bestower of liberation.

To swing in supersensuous joy is the speciality of the confluence-aged Brahmins.

However, any bondage of thoughts in your mind will not allow you to experience inner happiness or supersensuous joy. To be tied by some bondage of waste thoughts, jealousy, carelessness or thought of laziness is a bondage of the mind. Out of ego, such souls will always continue to think of blaming others. Their power of realization finishes and this is why they have to be liberated from these subtle bondages for only then will they be able to become bestowers of liberation.



PRAJAPITA BRAHMA – THE APOSTLE OF GOD



ada Lekharaj was born as an ordinary person in a village in Sindh, Hyderabad. He had a spiritual bent of mind. Due to his sheer hard work and endeavour, he had risen to become a diamond merchant. His business was mainly located at Kolkata. From there he operated his business extending to Mumbai and other places. He was married and had children. When he was 60 years old, he started getting divine visions of the old world being destroyed by world war, natural calamities and civil war. He was also getting enlightenment about his own life and personality. He got the knowledge that all the human beings are souls, points of divine light, i.e., the life force, which is giving life to the body. All the activities are done by this divine entity, called the soul, through the medium of body. He is also a soul, who is immortal. The soul, when the body becomes old, leaves the body and takes another body and continues to play its roles birth after birth on the world drama stage.

This world is a huge drama stage. All the souls in all the religions are spiritual energies enacting their roles through the bodies. All souls are immortal; they are spiritually brothers. Along with the visions of destruction, he also had the vision of tiny stars descending and becoming divine beings – deities. In the midst of these visions and his own experience of confusions and wonders, he was not able to make out specifically as to what was happening in his life. In the meanwhile, he had the vision of the Supreme Light, who is the Supreme Spiritual Father of all souls, and indicating to him that he should become the

instrument for establishing the new world of deities and deity religion (Adi Sanathan Devi Devata Dharma). He was told that the current period is the end of Iron Age (Kaliyuga) and this old world will perish on its own under the weight of its own sinful acts. At the same time, a new world of deities will emerge. He was told that since he got the enlightenment of his own self and the abode of God and the souls, the beginning, middle and end of the Creation and the knowledge about his own self and Almighty Father, he is given the spiritual name - Prajapita Brahma. The Supreme Father started speaking to the human beings of the humanity through the mouth organ of Prajapita Brahma, and revealing that He is the Incorporeal Self-Effulgent Light, He



never comes in birth, death and rebirth cycle, but has descended in the body of Prajapita Brahma in the Confluence Age (the period of transition between the Iron Age and Golden Age) for the divine t as k of World

Transformation. He observes that He should come down to the level of human beings to reveal to humanity the secret of Creator and Creation. This present period is the most auspicious Confluence Age. The home of all souls is Incorporeal World (*Paramdham*) which is beyond the sun, moon, stars, galaxies and the outer space. The Supreme Father permanently abides there in the highest metaphysical world (*Paramdham*).

The Revelation of God

The Supreme Father, the Light of all lights, started descending in the body of Brahma from 1937. He unequivocally proclaims that He descends only once in 5000 years, which is called the *Kalpa* – a period of 5000 years for establishing Peace, Purity and Prosperity on

earth. The Time Cycle has four parts, Golden, Silver, Copper and Iron Ages. Once, it is completed again it repeats identically. He also openly announces that He descends to establish the Adi Sanatan deity religion, through Brahma Vidya - a package of Sarvavidya Pratishta. He is enacting three roles: as the Supreme Father He is sustaining the souls with happiness and peace; as the Supreme Teacher, He is teaching the souls the art of living technique and Rajyoga meditation to purge the souls of all the sins and to purify them; and as the Supreme Preceptor, He is teaching the souls the art of empowering the soul, of becoming soulconscious from body consciousness and the ability to leave the body on its own, to win over death.

He is proclaiming that He has descended to establish the ancient most - first religion - on earth on the basis of psycho-socio-cum-spiritual education. This education is open to all the souls, who belong to all the religions of the world. It is universal education; therefore, He has established a Vishwa Vidyalaya - World University - for the world. He has opened innumerable study centres - Rajyoga Meditation and Godly Knowledge education centres - in all continents of the world to educate the souls. Those souls, who are attracted to this education from all religions, are being taught by the Supreme Himself through His daily sermons from the Mount Abu in Rajasthan. He is teaching the souls to be self-sovereigns so as to become the emperor and empress of the Golden Age -Heaven. Through this education, the souls qualify themselves to be completely virtuous, 16 celestial degrees of perfection, fully righteous and completely viceless. They will become flawless in all respects, healthy and wise, and most beautiful and handsome. When the souls come in contact with God, they become the children of Brahma also. Therefore, they are known as Brahma Kumars and Brahma Kumaris – the mouth-born children of Brahma. They are also known as the true Brahmins.

He declares that Adi Sanatan deity religion is the most ancient religion in the world which was established in Akhand Bharat. When He establishes this religion, He also establishes deity kingdom. This religion and kingdom will be intact for 2500 years because this is established by God through Prajapita Brahma on the basis of spiritual education. Another important announcement is that He has come to take back home His children, the souls of all religions back to His abode *Paramdham* and the drama is going on. The employees should learn to recognize business ethics issues, the dilemmas and the associated best practices to avoid personal and organizational harm. They should learn to build and maintain a respectful workplace and improve the performance. The organizations that conduct business in an ethical manner have higher employee retention, more productive employees and demonstrated customer loyalty. Therefore, it is necessary to remove ignorance regarding ethical behaviour.

The ideal solution for promoting ethical behavior is not a punitive one but a positive approach by the leaders of organizations. Ethical behavior must be practised by the leaders. Ethical decision making should be rewarded in the system and process of Corporation so that ethics and leadership can go hand in hand in practical life and behaviour.

The court of public opinion is stronger than ever, but being on the game is not an assurance that all is correct. Leaders must demonstrate the good faith to achieve ethical behaviour. No industry is immune from what is deemed acceptable and appropriate behavior in the court of public opinion.

The business leaders, therefore, have a responsibility for the business environment that they create, called "Corporate Culture". Ethical business leadership can encourage or discourage ethical behaviour and create the circumstances in which good people are able to

do good, and bad people are prevented from doing bad. Is compliance with the law all that is required to behave ethically? If the law was clear and unambiguous, there would not be much a role for lawyers and courts.

Leaders hold positions of power that come with special trust and confidence. Ethics win trust and trust wins business. Morality of leadership depends on the particulars of the relationship among the people. Ethical leadership is a life-time experience. To be a good leader, one should be aware of self-behaviour and personal mentoring.

In the pursuit of economic benefits, business operations cannot be separated from the influences of social, political and cultural impacts, including those of religion. And these influences cannot be managed by economic and legal actions alone; they have to be dealt with ethical considerations as well.

The discourses around the world have changed profoundly in last five years, and stronger voices have emerged asking global corporations to improve the human conditions. Many companies are increasingly finding their voices. Many companies have invested strategically in a sound ethics and compliance programme, and have worked hard to earn the trust of their customers and business partners, inspire their employees, deliver the value for their shareholders and improve their communities. Recent research reports showed that the world's most Ethical Companies, in particular, continued to show exemplary leadership in global business. Doing business with integrity matters for corporations.

"Business" or "economic" decisions and "ethical" decisions are not mutually exclusive. The fact that a decision is made on economic grounds does not mean that it does not involve ethical considerations as well. Being sensitive to ethical issues is a vital characteristic that needs

to be cultivated in ethically responsible people. Understanding one's own character and values should play a role in decision-making.

Sometimes, corporate or social environment is rife with ethical challenges and unethical decisions. It is simply easier to do the wrong thing. Sometimes, people make decisions they later regret because they lack courage to do otherwise. We tend to give in to peer pressure in our professional environments, because we want to "fit in" and to achieve success in our organizations, and also because our actual thinking is influenced by our peers.

Self-regulation - self-imposed standards of behaviour with reference to codes and principles of corporate governance - can correct and moderate the path of success. Culture of self-regulation starts with individuals and refers to individual thoughts, values and beliefs, which have a cumulative effect on corporate business and governance. Regulations/laws and self-regulations are complimentary approaches for ethical governance and sustainable results.

Practice of humility free up leaders to be happy and help build true connections and human relationships. Curiosity helps leaders to continuously learn new things and adapt. Humility helps leaders to unlearn selectively the past baggage and move on in the journey of life. Introspections help leaders to realize who they are but do not allow them to challenge their own views. Leaders should also understand how others see them. Leaders should always seek out with empathy and value other's viewpoints. Organizations tend to be healthiest where there is a supremacy of ideas, where people are willing to listen to the youngest person in the room, provided, of course, that he or she has the facts.

Will you remain passive and simply conform to social and cultural expectations to "go with the flow"? or to live a meaningful human life, you will reflect on your decisions, assuming the responsibility of autonomous beings. •

SAMADHI IS NOT ABOUT DEATH: ONE CAN EXPERIENCE IT WHILE LIVING

ccording to the sage Patanjali, *Rajyoga* is a way of life spread through eight stages such as *Yama* (abstaining from vices), *Niyama* (adopting virtues), *Asana* (sitting in relaxed posture), *Pranayama* (control of lifeforce energies through some system of breathing), *Pratyahara* (withdrawing attention from sense-driven information), *Dharana* (turning one's attention inward), *Dhyana* (meditation), and finally *Samadhi* (achieving equanimity and absorption in bliss).

This shows that *Samadhi* is the effect whereas preceding seven stages are the cause. These seven stages are like various stages of a student life from kindergarten to any higher degree, such as engineering, and the 8th stage is like the remaining period of life in which he works as an engineer. That is why this stage is named *samadhi* which literally means *sama* (equanimity) and *dhi* (*buddhi* or the intellect). Viewing all happenings with an equanimous intellect has to do with 'living', but not with 'dying'. If you reach an equanimous state of intellect, it is known as *Samadhi*. This is in contrast to the fundamental nature of the intellect, which is to discriminate.

Samadhi comes after following a life of consistent practice of meditation. The original word for meditation is *dhyana*, a combination of *dhee* (intellect) and *ayana* (travel), which

denotes journey of intellect to the Supreme Soul to imbibe His qualities such as knowledge, peace, love, joy, purity, power and bliss. The real meditation is possible only after acquiring true knowledge about oneself (the soul) and the Supreme Soul. And true knowledge is received only in the concluding phase of every Kalpa (a cycle of 5000 years) when God Himself directly teaches Rajyoga to the willing children. That means true meditation and true Samadhi happen in our time. As one experiences linking with the Almighty, his/her priorities in life change, and he/she becomes "dead to what the world is awake, and awake to what the world is dead," (The Gita-2:69), which, in other words, means one dies alive or undergoes a living death - dead to one's old habit of seeking self-importance and pleasure-seeking and alive to doing everything in remembrance of God and leading a simple life. But, unfortunately, this figurative death that happens with regard to one's attitude, was later wrongly applied to physical death, and the word Samadhi wrongly became synonym for physical death.

God-given knowledge and constant link with God through practice of Rajyoga meditation enable one to see life in its true working and in its totality, and, thus, also to view drama of life as something wholly good. Even with regard to its part, or each happening, one has the correct view: Every action or happening is like the sprouting of a seed, which happens because of many causes and forces (perceptible or imperceptible) coming together, and every result too is like sprouting of a seed, which happens because of many factors and forces (perceptible or imperceptible) coming together. This means that there is logic in all happenings. Those, who are aware of this fact, have a favorable

All and temptations of this temporal world won't haunt you as you feel timeless.

disposition (aradhana) towards everything that happens in and around them. A person with such mind-set could be called Radha, which reminds us of the love between Radha and Krishna. The love between them is called platonic love, typical of love between friends, but not of married persons. If one operates from such love and views everything that happens, what a marvelous life would be with nothing to complain about! That means accepting the drama of life with pleasantness is worship (aradhana).

Conversely, finding fault with drama of life or not seeing the cause-effect relationship between happenings is self-deceptive and even equal to "mocking God", states The Bible (Galatians - 6:7) This is because there is nothing to complain as everything serves a purpose. If one says, "I like fruit-bearing trees but not the mud", it makes no sense because there are no trees without mud. Even a painful situation may turn out to be a blessing later and vice versa. For example, a soldier named Ignatious Loyala, who was severely wounded in the war-field, experienced a conversion that ultimately resulted in founding of Society of Jesus, a Roman Catholic Order of priests and brothers, which grew into a huge organization producing many scholars and charitable institutions worldwide. Its opposite also is true. The flourishing business may plunge into heavy loss at the arrival of new technology. Life is full of such dualities. They come to us as one following the other. They are like a coin having two sides if you want one side, you automatically must accept the other. Even when unloved and defrauded, it doesn't disturb those, who are taught by God, because they know that people act according to their sanskar or temperament

(which means giving what others deserve is not their concern – they simply unfold according to their sanskar or temperament). When others act according to their sanskar, equanimous intellect would say: "I should act according to my Godly sanskar – doing everything in remembrance of God, and keeping myself linked to His qualities and powers, which would make me feel full. This would make me like a well-lit house, thereby remaining unaffected when other houses go into occasional black-outs.

Such equanimous intellect views even the world situations in the above mind-set. While people may lament over the deteriorating situations of the world, the equanimous intellect would see things in their totality and say that history is a cycle of rule of virtues (in the first half of the *Kalpa*) and rule of vices (in the second half of the *Kalpa*) – one half follows the other half like day and night. This is inevitable because there are only two possibilities – people love God for some time, then their love decays into love of the things of His Creation. In other words, people would live in *yog* (in remembrance of God) for a time, then they live in *viyog* (in separation) with each stage creating a thirst for the other.

This knowledge about the cyclic nature of the history too enables one to manifest equanimous intellect with ease. Such one always keeps a balance, which is symbolized by the one foldedleg position of Ganesh. The leg that rests on the ground stands for doing of affairs of the world and the other leg, which is folded, denotes the meditative living. This reflects a balance between practical and spiritual life, doing everything as an offering to God. This makes sense because the problem with going for worldly accomplishment with *full* force is that you


always need another greater accomplishment to feel good (which means there cannot be real contentment through worldly means because mind is not meant to feel full with mere material accomplishments); and even if you become number one in the world, the unanswerable question would still haunt you: "I became number one, so what? or is it of any benefit?" The good feeling in you disappears soon because such success incites envy in others.

On the contrary, spiritual pursuit does give equanimous intellect full contentment of which you can find proof in the lives of those, who have already practised or are practising Rajyoga. We invite all the truth-seekers to practise Rajyoga meditation, which offers not only Samadhi (equanimity and absorption in bliss), but also samadhan (solution) to all problems. ❖


he World Drama Wheel or the Time Cycle has been equally divided into four ages namely the Golden Age (Satyuga), Silver Age (Tretayuga), Copper Age (Dwaparyuga) and Iron Age (Kaliyuga). It is only The Shrimat Bhagavad Gita, the sacred book or The Vedas of the Hindus that have such a valuable information about the Eras and Ages (i.e., length of each period), which no other holy book like The Quran, The Bible, The Pali, The Granth Sahib contains. It is obvious that only those, who have practically experienced or witnessed the scenes or occurrences, could have the authority to speak about the sequence of such events or phenomena. However, during these eras, chaos, commotions, catastrophe and apocalypse occurred and gradually caused the segmentations and fragmentations of the single united Bharat. The super-conscious human beings, called the deities, who enjoyed and experienced ever healthy, ever wealthy, ever happy and ever holy heavenly life both in Satyuga and Tretayuga, lost their immunity to balance their mind and body, while the scenes of anti-climax were faced by them during such periods.

It could be noticed that while the Founder Fathers of all other religions (i.e., Christianity – Christ; Islam – Abraham; Muslim - Prophet Mohammed; Buddhism – Sidharth; Sikhism – Guru Nanak; Jainism – Mahavir, etc.), are identifiable, the Founding Father of Hinduism is not known. As a result, those, who came on the world drama stage at a later time, gave their own interpretations and misinterpretations. After the

culmination of the *Dwaparyuga*, many *Sadhus*, *Sanyasis*, etc. appeared on the Drama Stage and mesmerized people with their own theories on the basis of the little knowledge they had. The human beings started racing behind them in pursuit of a better living on the earth. Also, man became a slave to the sensuality and did not bother about its cause and effect and started committing sinful actions, being quite unmindful of the resultant effects.

The super-conscious, soul-conscious deities and angels stepped down from the top of the ladder of heavenly life, birth after birth, right from the inception of the dawn at Satyuga and rolled down into the bottom of the dusk and, thus, the legend of the deities' heavenly life came to an end. At the inception of the Dwaparyuga, the day of Brahma was set off and the Night of Brahma set in; the messengers like Abraham, Buddha and Jesus Christ came down to this corporeal world at different points of time in the various parts of the world and guided the souls with the pure knowledge they had. INCORPOREAL GOD FATHER SHIVA'S DIVINE DIRECTIONS (MURLI): THE CATALYTIC ELIXIR FOR DIVINE LIFE OF THE BRAHMINS AND DEITIES

n Pharmacology, the term 'elixir' refers to a sweetened aromatic solution of alcohol and water containing, or used as a vehicle for, medicinal substances. Described as a phrase 'elixir of life', it refers to an alchemic preparation formerly believed to be capable of prolonging life. It refers to an alchemic preparation earlier believed to be capable of transmuting base metals into gold. In fact, Incorporeal God Father Shiva's Supreme Directions (Murlis) serve as the catalytic elixir for divine life of the Brahmins and Deities. The Murli serves to transform the Iron-aged life of Kaliyugi Shudra type of human souls into the Diamondaged life of the Brahmins and then into the Golden-aged life of the deities. It also serves to prolong the longevity of both the Brahmins and the deities. In this article, the author highlights the essential importance and significance of the Incorporeal God Father Shiva's Supreme Directions (Murli) in its various aspects.

What is *Murli*?

Murli is Incorporeal God Father Shiva's direct utterances through the lotus mouth of Prajapita Brahma, His human body-chariot. The lotus mouth of Prajapita Brahma has found mention in religious literatures as Cow's Mouth (Gau Mukh) from which water flows or gushes out. This is symbolic of the flowing out of God Shiva's nectar of spiritual knowledge through the lotus mouth of Brahma for satisfying the spiritual thirst of impure human souls. On the basis of this knowledge, the souls forget their body-

consciousness and become soul-conscious, and thereby purify them of sins through the practice Rajyoga meditation.

In the cult of devotion (*Bhakti Marga*), reference about this knowledge is made to the immortal anecdote (*Amar Katha*) or *Tijri Katha* of Lord Shiva delivered to Parvati, His consort, on the Mount Kailash. This is again symbolic in the sense that the immortal anecdote (*Amar Katha*) refers to the immortal spiritual knowledge, and the *Tijri Katha* refers to the *third eye* of spiritual knowledge, and Parvati refers to every human soul, who is called/symbolized as the bride of Incorporeal God Shiva, who is the only Spiritual Bridegroom of all human souls, the spiritual brides.

Murli - The Real Flute

The real flute is not the instrument made of bamboo but is divine utterance of Incorporeal God Father Shiva. References are also cited to the sweet and sonorous sound of Krishna's flute (Murli). It is said that when the sound of Krishna's flute is heard, the cows and cattle magically run and flock towards him being quite spellbound by the attractive and touching spell of its sound. Even the devoted women (Gopis) of Vrindaban were madly in love with such sound and flee towards the direction of this sound by leaving their household chores or activities in which they were then engaged. This is again symbolic: the soul of Brahma and Krishna is the same but their bodies are different in Age of Transition (Sangam Yuga) and Golden Age (Satyuga); in

Remain ever in a sense of self-respect, then you won't wish respect from others.

Sangam Yuga, the Incorporeal God Shiva enters in Brahma's body-chariot to deliver the sweet spiritual knowledge (Gyan Murli) to the human souls, who represent or symbolize the Brahma Kumars and Brahma Kumaris, the real Gopas and Gopis respectively. So, the Incorporeal God Shiva, but not the corporeal Krishna, is the real or bonafide Flutist (Murlidhar) of Spiritual Knowledge.

Murli - The First Utterances of God

When the Incorporeal God Father Shiva descends down upon the earth and enters in the body-chariot of Brahma, He gave His own introduction through the lotus mouth of Brahma by delivering His first utterances, thus: "Nijananda Swarupam Shivoham, Shivoham; Prakash Swarupam Shivoham, Shivoham; Gyan_Swarupam Shivoham, Shivoham" (I am the Blissful Self, I am Shiva, I am Shiva; I am the Effulgent Self, I am Shiva, I am Shiva; I am the Knowledgeful Self; I am Shiva, I am Shiva." Therefore, these words are called the first utterances of Murli.

These initial divine utterances of God pouring out through Adam, the First Man, who is designated to be the First Deity (*Adi Dev*) of Heaven prove the fact that the ancient saints and sages were quite ignorant of the clear and sufficient knowledge of God, regarding whom they utter the words "neti neti" (no end, no end), which means that they have not reached to the 'end' of the "what, how, where, when" of God. The term 'what' refers to His 'name'; 'how' refers to His 'form'; 'where' refers to His 'abode' and 'when' refers to the auspicious time of His divine 'descent' upon the earth.

Murli – The Gita in True Sense of the Term

Murli, in reality, is *The Gita* – the divine songs or utterances or commandments – of God in true sense of the term. According to the versions of *The Gita*, He descends down upon the earth to

salvage the religion and the righteous souls, as stated, thus: "Whenever the religion or righteousness declines in Bharat (*Yadayadahi Dharmasya Glanirbhavati Bharat*), I take divine birth in order to evolve the religion, salvage the righteous souls and destroy the unrighteous ones." Thus, the true Sermonizer of the real Scripture *The Gita* is the Incorporeal God Father Shiva but not the corporeal Krishna.

He does this by sermonizing *Murli/The Gita* not in every age (*Yuga*) but only once in the Confluence Age (*Sangam Yuga*), the Age of Transition, in every *Kalpa*, which consists of a period of 5,000 years in the ever revolving and repetitive Cycle of Time and Creation that go on forever without any end or stop everlastingly. Because, the Time and Creation are the eternal phenomena, which are unstoppable; only their nature changes from purest to pure (*Sattopradhan* to *Satto*), from pure to semi-pure (*Satto* to *Rajo* and *Rajopradhan*), from semi-pure to impure (*Rajopradhan* to *Tamo*), and from impure to most impure (*Tamo* to *Tamopradhan*).

Murli Liberates, Redeems and Elevates

Liberation, redemption and elevation are the objectives of the longest spiritual journey of human souls in the course of human life. Since the commencement of the Copper Age (*Dwapar Yuga*), the human souls started experiencing the fall from God's grace and heavenly freedom and came into bondages due to body-consciousness that culminates at the end of the Iron Age (*Kaliyuga*) in utmost hellish pains and sufferings.

Redemption of the human spirit/soul involves acceptance, confession and expiation of their sins/vices by acquiring righteous knowledge and following the righteous and noble path guided by none other than the Supreme, Incorporeal and Spiritual Guide through His corporeal human medium, Prajapita Brahma, through whose lotus mouth He delivers the sacred and redemptive

spiritual knowledge, called Murli.

Elevation of the human spirit/soul involves the divine interference of Supreme Divine and Almighty Being, the Highest External Spiritual Force or Power, who is solely responsible for making a quantum shift or leap or transformation of human consciousness from their hellish state of body-consciousness to their heavenly state of soul-consciousness through His divine magic wand. That is why God is called the Supreme and most Wonderful Magician (*Jadugar*), who transforms the Iron-aged human souls into Golden-aged divine souls by His unprecedented magical touch.

Murli has the tremendous transformative power to liberate the impure and decadent human souls from the gripping clutches of the seven deadly sins/vices such as sex-lust, anger, greed, attachment, ego, indolence and jealousy. It redeems them by diverting them from the dark dungeons of ignoble, untrue and unrighteous path to the noble, true and righteous path of divine life. It also elevates them from their current hellish human stage to the forthcoming heavenly deity stage in which they will lead the purest life of primordial and pristine peace, bliss and happiness untainted by any iota of impurity and devilishness.

Murli Quenches the Thirst of Souls for Divine Knowledge

Just like the partridge birds await longer and seek to drink the first rain drops after the scorching heat of summer, likewise the human souls, who are seared by the scorching fire of body-consciousness and suffer from unprecedented pains and agonies, seek to satisfy their long-lingering thirst for divine or spiritual knowledge of God, which only *Murli* quenches at last. The outpourings of spiritual nectar of knowledge work as *balms* for their

pains and sufferings, pacify them with *solace* by providing them shady *protection* and *succour* from the fiery vices, and heal them with *spiritual injection*, which are badly needed for their ultimate spiritual transformation and rejuvenation after a long period of hellish damnation.

Murli takes Human Souls back to their Original Nature (Vritti) and to the Lap of Nature (Prakriti)

Under the negative impact of sins/vices in the Iron Age (Kaliyuga), the human souls were completely digressed from their original, essential and fundamental spiritual nature (Vritti), and had adopted the vicious Satanic nature of sensuality, perversity, promiscuity, depravity, criminality, etc. As a result, they were far removed from their original values-based spiritual lifestyle and indulged themselves in the materialistic, hedonistic and flamboyant lifestyle of degrading consumerism culture. They were also far removed from the dictum of "simple living and high thinking" that they once used to live and think in the lap of beautiful, attractive, fostering love and care of Mother Nature, which, in the words of romantic poet William Wordsworth, regarded as the worshipper of Nature, "never did betray the heart that loved her".

Murli takes the human souls back to their original nature (Vritti) by giving them a real foothold in their original values-based spiritual lifestyle, and also brings them "Back to the Lap of Nature (Prakriti)" and also to the simple, natural and pure lifestyle from the humdrum and wilderness of modern, materialistic, depraved, corrupt, nasty, brutish, promiscuous and artificial lifestyle of the present industrial culture of materialism and consumerism in this fallen civilization. here are various forms of sleep or dormant state in youth life such as sleeping in the lap of ignorance; Sleeping in indulgence and luxury; Sleeping out of hopelessness and depression; Sleeping because of ambiguity, duality, confusion, lack of clarity; sleeping out of negligence. Lack of inner awareness or self-awareness is a spiritual sleep.

Sleeping in lap of ignorance is a trap for someone, who has no wisdom. This includes over confidence of fate and fortune without doing anything. The youth is reluctant to learn or strive hard according to his goal. If one is overconfident, time may run out. The urgent new is to strengthen one's mental muscles to give importance to things which have been neglected by the self.

The words such as "I will see, will do, will plan; let me think; things will happen on time, etc." are the words of negligence. The youth should hear alarm, which awakens them from such sleeps of negligence. This kind of alarm includes constructive criticism from parents, teachers and other well-wishers. But, they stay negligent to such alarms, they have the habit to ignore such alarms, they don't respond to them, and that is dangerous. There are warning bells, which needs to be heard, but we ignore them. Fortune knocks the door only once and it is upto us to take the opportunity.

One needs understanding and power to hear alarm. Attention is the key. There is the need also of energy and enthusiasm. The young minds are

not ready to understand what one may face due to ignorance. One must accept, be humble in understanding such kind of sleep. Otherwise, one will be under pressure and tension. In the beginning, this may look okay but later this will damage one's life.

Intense effort (sadhana) and accomplishment (siddhi)

Intense or systematic effort (Sadhana) is luck in itself. One needs intense effort just to find the right way to achieve one's objectives. During Ph.D. the researcher takes several years just to understand the problem and additional six months to have the information about the relevant books. When he was in search of papers of various authors, he couldn't understand or differentiate between the relevant, less relevant or irrelevant papers. After meeting his guide he understands that some of the works or papers are seminal, which means path-breaking research papers. In this process, he tries to set the objectives of his research after going through the research works.

One may try hard but if it's not in the right direction, it damages. Right *Sadhana* leads to *Siddhi*. After identifying the correct direction and path, one can enhance the speed. But, direction is more important than speed.

Working with smartness or cunningness may offer one limited advantage, and one may even lose the battle in the long run. Working with proper conscience, understanding and clarity gives one immediate relief and victory. Otherwise, psychological energy gets exhausted in ambiguity, self-doubt and fear of the unknown. Working with clarity gives one confidence and courage to confront obstacles. In *The Gita*, it is stated that the Mahabharata War was all about the battle of the minds. In their

See the world and humanity with the third eye of knowledge, they will look more beautiful.

mind, Pandavas were confident of their Guide or Mentor; so, they fought with the mental qualities of bravery, complete faith and focus. In their mind, Kauravas were aggressive and focused but were lacking the mental qualities of confidence, clarity and faith in others.

Plato, the Athenian philosopher, said, "The first and best victory is to conquer the self." It is better to be the conqueror of the self than winning a thousand wars. Here, victory means victory over one's own mental weaknesses, bad habits, vices, negativities, etc.

John F. Kennedy said, "Victory has a hundred fathers and defeat is an orphan." It tells us that when you win, everyone wants to be your friend. When you are defeated no one wants to be around. Indian athlete Ms. Hima Das was not known to anyone before she became victorious in sprint running.

Your victory relates to the victory of so many people. One's victory leads to success and gives benefit to family and friends. A youth achieving success in getting a seat in a prestigious medical college leads to victory of his/her parents,

teachers and near and dear ones.

Maintaining the positivity in mind and self and remaining victorious are connected. Realizing the self as the child of God, the Almighty and accompanying Him during our journey towards victory will solve our problems. Digesting victory is equally important as remaining humble and grounded in spite of our spectacular performances. ❖

tricks, evil thoughts, worries, etc., find their breeding place in it. Besides, he spreads unrest in society by his unsocial acts.

Attachment in any form, either to one's own body, to property or to any other thing, kills one's reasoning faculty, leads him to nepotism and partiality, and to illegal ways or exploitations. He becomes the means of causing calamity, conflict and even a bloody revolution. To what length does a man not go when attachment to his offsprings and to his hearth and home lead him, as it were, by the nose, to dirty deeds?

Egotism or pride is the root cause of all the conflicts. It is because of this that there are clashes between two individuals, two countries or two nations. A conceited person simply causes distress to others and, on a small excuse, may retort and raise his hand.

Sexual indulgence leads to loss of strength and to disease, anger and intolerance. Obviously, unrest is in the persons in whom these vices exist or in place where they exist. In short, vices generate restlessness in one form or the other as much in the society as in an individual.

What is the Root Cause of vices?

Body-consciousness is the root cause of all viciousness. Only when man considers himself a body instead of a soul, views himself as a man or a woman and looks at others too from purely physical point of view and behaves in accordance with physical relationships, being aware of various forms of these relationships, only then does arise there the vice, called sexlust. When one observes all things and persons from the standpoint of corporeality, attachment towards one's children and one's kith and kin is born. Being attached to them, one becomes greedy and, as is generally observed, his conceit suffers a shock because his desires are far from being fulfilled and he loses his temper. To a far-

sighted man, this truth is clearer than to the one, who has mere superficial knowledge.

Ignorance Leads to all these Vices

Vices have their origin in body-consciousness, which is due to ignorance. Ignorance of what? Ignorance of what man really is, his original home wherefrom he, as a soul, has arrived in this world; whose child, he, as a soul, is and his religion, ignorance of his destination or the aim of his life and what course his actions will take? So, knowledge of all these points, mentioned here, should bring peace to man's mind and by this means alone can be found a solution to this problem of world unrest. By dint of this knowledge, these causes will surely be removed from man's mind.

Solutions to Territorial or Regional Differences

Let us take the example of territorial differences as a cause of unrest. If people realised that they are souls, and that the bodies, they have, are simply the instruments of action or garments of the souls and that, in reality, they are the original inhabitants of one and the same metaphysical world, called Paramdham or Brahmalok from where they have come into this physical world and to where they, at last, have to return; then the prospects of lasting peace begin to appear. Not to speak of a particular country, the whole world is a caravan of people searching for peace. By this thinking, union of minds among all can be made possible and mutual trust generated. This is the truth on which we should reflect that all the souls cannot be born in only one country or to one father and mother in the same linguistic group. Hence, in this vast world of activity, some souls are born in one country while some others are born in another country. About this, there can be no occasion for quarrel. Should it be a reason enough for passengers in a train to quarrel among themselves simply

because they occupy seats in different compartments? No, surely not. Actually, the destination of all is one – the Soul World (*Paramdham*) – and the attainment of peace and happiness is the aim of all alike. This realization of a common aim can bring about oneness among the people.

Does anyone carry with them the piece of the land in which they are born? The great conqueror Alexander, the Great, left this world with his hands empty and when his mother went to the graveyard and enquired about where her son's grave was, the man in-charge (the sexton) replied: "Here are interned several bodies bearing that name (Alexander). Which one do you ask me about?" When such was the fate of Alexander, the Great, all men should remember that this body will be consigned to flames one day or will mix with the common dust.

If each one of us were, thus, informed on this point, namely that in the body resides a priceless, immortal, spiritual and eternal entity, called the soul, and we all have come from the Soul-World, (Paramdham), the idea of universal brotherhood will be installed to enable them to love one another. How happy people of a country, community or tribe are, when they have a chance to meet them in a foreign country? They set up associations, clubs and unions only to help one another. So, we should also co-operate with one another because we have come from one and the same metaphysical place (Paramdham) into this world, which is really an alien country. We should have concord amongst ourselves. Knowledge of this kind will release man from greediness, attachment or any sense of false identification and, having this universal brotherhood engendered, will bring peace to the

world.

Solution to Religious Differences

Now, let us think of the religious differences, which are a potent source of unrest. If all were taught to learn that purity and peace are the prime objective of the soul to acquire, peace will be established in the world and in the mind of man. You should be able to say that Hindus, Sikhs, Christians, Parsis - all are essentially and primarily souls. Before we regard ourselves as belonging to any religion, we should recognise ourselves as souls and should look upon others also as souls. Thus, there will be no occasion to lose peace of mind, because the soul's very objective is the attainment of peace and purity. We have to take note of the fact that, now-adays, the slogan of the general public and their leaders is that people, whatever their religious beliefs, are all brothers. But, unfortunately, they do not live like brothers, because they know not what the basis of this idea is, nor have they the experience of how this idea works in other people's lives. So, there is obviously the necessity to make people understand the truth that all persons, wherever they live and whether they follow one religion or the other, are the children of one and the same Spiritual Incorporeal Father, the Supreme Soul, and are, therefore, spiritual brothers to one another. From the point of view of this material world, Brahma is the religious Father (Adi Pita), whom they call Adam or the First Man. Hence, it is now quite clear that when you have faith that you are a soul and look upon others, too, as souls, you will have the experience of what real spiritual brotherhood means. You will be linked to others with love and, as a result of that mutual relationship, there will be peace in the world. .

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
